



COMMONWEALTH FORESTRY CONFERENCE 2017 3-7APRIL DEHRADUN I INDIA

The world today is undergoing rapid socio-economic and technological changes, which have implications for the forest and environment sector, in turn, affecting the ecological, economic and social wellbeing of the people. The forestry sector must keep pace and adapt to these changes. The "Commonwealth" refers to the Commonwealth of Nations, an association of 53 sovereign nations that work together to achieve international goal of peace, democracy, law, human rights and sustainable development with greater trust and mutual understanding. Forests are global resources and need to be managed in accordance with international laws, conventions and agreements to address local and national requirements and mitigate pressures exacerbated by climate and environmental changes. The year 2017 will be a key occasion for forestry professionals, academicians and all those interested in and associated with forestry sector in the Commonwealth. They will gather and share their experiences with a view to learn and develop a vision for the future that will involve inclusive and sustainable growth and development. The first Commonwealth Forestry Conference was held in 1920 in London. Since then, the conferences have been held regularly to discuss various aspects of management of forests and focus the action on the changing priorities of the forestry sector.






## **DEHRADUN**

Dehradun, the capital city of the state of Uttarakhand, is one of the oldest cities of India, nestled in the foothills of the Himalayas at about 640 meters above mean sea level. Weather during April is generally pleasant (24-30°C). The weather starts to get warm but is well within the comfortable limit. Light cottons are recommended. Hill stations of Mussoorie and Dhanaulti, and religious places viz. Haridwar and Rishikesh situated along the Ganges, are popular tourist places located within a radius of 60 km from Dehradun.

Dehradun is well connected to New Delhi (national capital) by air, rail and road. FRI is situated in the New Forest campus (on Dehradun-Chakrata highway) and is about 30 km from Jolly Grant Airport, Dehradun, 6 km from the Dehradun Railway Station and 8 km from Inter-State Bus Terminus (ISBT). Jet Airways, Indigo and Air-India operate daily flights to Dehradun from Delhi and Mumbai.

Submission of an abstract implies consent by the author (s) to have the abstract published by the Conference (if it is decided so).
